

Sawtooth Aucuba



Aucuba japonica 'Serratifolia'

- **Use:** Broad-leaved evergreen shrub valued for the long dark green leaves with sharply serrated edges. Showy red berries in fall. Bold upright stems. An excellent accent for shady situations.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun– shade; moist, well drained soil. Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Slow-growing to 4 to 6 feet high, almost as wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Broad-leaved evergreen shrub valued for the showy dark green leaves with bright golden-yellow centers. Bold upright stems.
- **Flower:** Insignificant flowers.
