

Azalea Chojuho



Azalea 'Chojuho' (Satsuki type)

- **Use:** A fantastic Satsuki hybrid, meaning Treasure of Age. The low growing habit is more vigorous compared to 'Chinzan'. This is fantastic specimen for bonsai or landscape use in morning sun and acidic soil. It works well in many garden settings including woodland plantings, mixed borders, and as a specimen.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Please amend the soil if you have red clay.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6ft. tall and 6' wide or wider.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Green leaves.
- **Flower:** The 1" flowers bloom red in spring and fade to green over a 2 month period, hence the name.
