

# Flame Creeper Azalea



Blooms several times during the spring and summer, with a final blast in late summer to early fall.

## ***Azalea 'Flame Creeper'*** (Satsuki hybrid)

- **Use:** Cascades over pots, baskets or walls. Low spreading habit. Excellent for the woodland or Japanese garden. Like most azaleas, Flame Creeper is a low maintenance creeper but with a high maintenance appearance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun to shade. We don't recommend full sun unless you have fantastic soil and irrigation. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Low grower 6 to 12 inches high and spreading 24 to 36 inches wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone;** 4 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; green leaves.
- **Flower:** Tosses forth intensely bright cherry-red to reddish-orange blooms in the spring and again in the summer and fall.
