

# Azalea 'Girard Christina'



**Clear rosy pink blossoms.**

## ***Azalea 'Christina' (Girard type— very cold hardy)***

- **Use:** Double rose-red blooms cover the shrub in a profusion of color in late spring. An excellent choice for a showy border or accent planting. Makes a great companion plant for Japanese Maples.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Takes on a broad, dense growing habit. Moderate grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall, 3 to 5 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone 5-9, shrub**
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Glossy deep green and holds well. The leaves take on a Mahogany color in the fall and winter.
- **Flower:** Flowers are large hose in hose 2.5-3" and a clear pink. Pleasingly ruffled and very floriferous. Mid-spring, March through April.
