

# Azalea Girard Crimson



**Good for use in flower beds. Rosy-red blossoms.**

## ***Azalea 'Girard Crimson'***

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. A hardy Girard hybrid with a dense, compact growth habit. Looks great planted within a grouping of Azaleas because of its differing leaves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 feet tall and 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** The glossy green foliage has a nice winter.
- **Flower:** Produces a magnificent spring display of large rosy-red crimson flowers up to 2 1/2" in diameter.
