Azalea 'Girard Rose' (Girard type— very cold hardy)

- **Use:** Premier flowering shrub for use as hedge, walkway border or in massed planting for impressive color display. Thrives in cold climates! Use as hedge, walkway border or in massed planting for impressive display.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall, 3 to 5 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen, foliage has tints of red in fall.
- **Flower:** Profuse single, deep rose-red blooms from late March through early April.
