Azalea 'The Robe' (Girard type— very cold hardy)

- **Use:** Girard Azaleas are very cold hardy and durable in the shade. Use as a tidy hedge, walkway border or in a mass planting for impressive display
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Takes on a broad, dense growing habit. Moderate grower to 3 to 4 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 5-9**, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Dark green hairy leaves with white margins
- **Flower:** Crimson red single flowers; Mid-spring, March through April.
