

Azalea Gwenda



Robin Hill azaleas work well massed or as specimens in woodland gardens, mixed borders, foundation plantings, and containers.

Azalea 'Gwenda' (Robin Hill type)

- **Use:** Perfect as a large growing hedge or in a shady spot in the landscape. It works well in many garden settings including woodland plantings, mixed borders, and as a specimen.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Please amend the soil if you have red clay.
- **Growth:** Semi-dwarf growth habit to 3 feet tall x 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Green leaves.
- **Flower:** Pale pink flowers in late season.
