## ***Azalea 'Hershey Orange' (Kurume type)***

- **Use:** Outstanding as a hedge or accent plant. A Kurume hybrid with an upright habit. Vivid, deep, double red-orange flowers contrast against the rich green leaves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun with irrigation, but prefers part sun/ part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 1-2 ft. tall and 3-4 ft. wide. Low and spreading. Makes an attractive ground cover.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Medium sized evergreen foliage on a low spreading form.
- **Flower:** Orange-red double hose in hose flowers bloom mid-season.
