

# Azalea Johanna



**Carmine-red blooms. Looks good all year. Highly recommended.**

## ***Azalea 'Johanna'***

- **Use:** A rounded, evergreen broadleaf shrub that will do well in containers. When in bloom it looks as though the entire plant is blanketed with color!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. We do not recommend growing azaleas in sun. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer in spring and fall.
- **Growth:** Vigorous, upright grower to 2 to 4 ft. tall and wide. Makes a lovely accent, border or hedge.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Dark shiny leaves turning dark red in autumn.
- **Flower:** Medium carmine-red flowers from April - May.
