

Johga Azalea



Azalea 'Johga' (Satsuki hybrid)

- **Use:** Evergreen shrub with 5 petaled spring blooms which often cover the plant. Compact habit. This family of Azaleas is often used for bonsai.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 2 ' tall and 3' wide in a compact mound.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Small, bright green leaves give year-round appeal.
- **Flower:** Late-Season. Variable white to light pink or purple flowers with flecks of purplish-pink.

**Good for use
in flower beds.**
