Azalea 'Pink Pearl' (Kurume type)

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. Blooms late March through April.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2 to 3 feet tall and 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; tiny foliage on a low spreading form.
- **Flower:** Soft pink with rose blotch, early hose-in-hose bloom.
