Azalea 'Poukhanence'

- <u>Use:</u> Yeah, we can't say the name either, but don't let that stop you from enjoying this spectacular Azalea. ..putting on a kickbutt display of color. And in case you're wondering, it's: pook-a-nense.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers part shade and moist, welldrained soil, but not soggy.
- <u>Growth</u>: A low spreading, compact grower 3'tall and 5' wide. Space 4-6' apart.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: 6-9; shrub
- <u>Foliage</u>: Small evergreen leaves. dark green leaves that offer impressive red-purple fall color.
- Flower: Beautiful rich lavender flowers bloom in late spring.
