

Azalea Red Slipper



Excellent as a color accent planted singly, or plant multiple plants that can be sheared for hedge or border.

Azalea 'Red Slipper'

- **Use:** A compact evergreen shrub with a rounded to spreading habit and attractive tiered branches. These popular evergreen shrubs are grown for their mid to late spring showy blooms and neat habit. Complete your spring wonderland with hostas and hardy ferns under these lovely azaleas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full to part sun (full sun only recommended with irrigation) and well draining, acidic soil types. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 2-3 ft. tall and 3-4 ft. wide in a mound. Makes an attractive ground cover.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The leaves are small, elliptical, glossy, dark green and hairy.
- **Flower:** "Fire house red" single to semi-double blooms are borne mid-season and will rebloom in fall.
