Azalea 'Vibrant' (Harris type)

- <u>Use</u>: Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. Blooms late March through April.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- Growth: Moderate grower to 3 to 4 feet tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; tiny foliage on a low spreading form.
- *Flower:* Clusters of large white single flowers with broad roase-red rim making a splendid show in spring.
