Azalea 'Vibrant' (Harris type)

- **Use:** Beautiful evergreen, premier shrub for use as hedge, screen or massed planting for impressive color display. Blooms late March through April.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 to 4 feet tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; tiny foliage on a low spreading form.
- **Flower:** Clusters of large white single flowers with broad roase-red rim making a splendid show in spring.
