Encore Azalea

- **Use:** Imagine having these lovely ruffled blooms decorating the yard and welcoming everyone who comes for Thanksgiving dinner. It is highly possible; Encore Azaleas have bloomed this late in areas where the weather allows them to keep up the virtual flower show. With light green foliage and ruffled pale pink flowers embellished by delicate white lacing and magenta freckles, this variety is a garden designer's delight. The robust, upright growing habit of Autumn Belle make this variety a landscaper's delight. You'll have lovely drought tolerance, once they establish in your soil.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Light shade to full sun. When planting you will want to make sure the roots have good drainage, azaleas of all types do not tolerate soggy soil. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Feed twice a year with a slow release fertilizer. Prefers slightly acidic well drained soils.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 5 feet tall and 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen The lush, dense green foliage grows into a semi-upright form.
- **Flower:** Semi-double pale pink blossoms are 2.5" wide in spring and fall.

Encore Azaleas are all very handsome and look great in your landscaping twelve months a year.
