

Sunjoy Citrus Barberry



A standout shrub producing bright yellow foliage all summer long, maturing to golden tones in fall; very showy, great as a color contrast in the landscape; plant on slopes, in beds, or as a border.

Berberis thunbergii 'Koren' USPP 24,818

- **Use:** This bright barberry has a neat, rounded habit that results in a uniformly ball-shaped plant. It makes an excellent low-maintenance hedge, needing little if any pruning to maintain its shape. This plant was evaluated for over five years in full sun to ensure excellent burn-resistance, so it will perform better in full sun than other yellow barberries.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Adaptable, but prefers well-drained soil. Best in full sun. Tolerates urban conditions like parking lots, street plantings. Pruning is seldom needed, but may be shaped in summer if necessary. Good drainage imperative, no red clay soils unless amended.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3 tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 4a-8b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Bright golden foliage that lasts into fall.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
