

Sunjoy Tangelo Barberry



Berberis thunbergia 'O'Byrne' PP#26,546

- **Use:** Unique orange foliage. Bright and cheery, Sunjoy® Tangelo™ barberry has tangy orange foliage that develops an appealing, distinctive chartreuse margin as it matures through the season. Stronger growing than conventional barberries, it is colorful in the landscape from spring to fall. Certified wheat-rust resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Adaptable, but prefers well-drained soil. Best in full sun. Tolerates urban conditions like parking lots, street plantings. Pruning is seldom needed, but may be shaped in summer if necessary. Good drainage imperative, no red clay soils unless amended.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-4 tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 4a-8b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Bright and cheery, this new barberry has vivid orange new growth that develops a distinctive chartreuse margin as the season goes on.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.

A zingy accent to spice up your landscape! Thorny stems are good for planting under windows for added security.
