- <u>Use</u>: This outstanding new barberry has the name Sunjoy Todo because it really does have it all: deeply colorful glossy foliage, bright flowers, a neat and useful habit, and absolutely no worries about invasiveness. Like other barberries, it offers low-maintenance color to sunny spots and is highly resistant to deer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Best in full sun. Adaptable, but prefers well-drained soil. Tolerates urban conditions like parking lots, street plantings. Pruning is seldom needed, but may be shaped in summer if necessary. Good drainage imperative, no red clay soils unless amended.
- **Growth**: Grows 18-24" tall and wide. Naturally grows as a tight mound without pruning.
- Hardiness: Zone 6a-8b; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Semi evergreen. The glossy, deep burgundy black foliage is very attractive in all seasons.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. Though the golden spring blooms do develop red berries, there is no seed within, as proven in multiple rounds of university testing.
