- <u>Use:</u> Buddleja Butterfly Candy is a very floriferous series. The flowers have a light, sweet fragrance and they are very attractive to butterflies and bees. This makes the Butterfly Candy series great for biodiversity. All the varieties.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. That's at least 6 hours. No cheating. Wait until it leafs out in spring before pruning. In some years you may have to prune it back to the ground. After milder winters, maybe not so much. Avoid fall pruning. Must have good drainage so keep them away from the gutter downspouts and low lying areas.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 2-3 feet tall and 2-3 feet wide. Deadhead often for best reblooming.
- Hardiness: Zone 5 -9 Shrub
- *Foliage*: Deciduous. Silvery green foliage.
- Flower: Large flowers the size you'd find on much taller plants. Each bloom is a full, dense cluster of blooms, emitting a honey-sweet fragrance and treating bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds to a tasty snack. Like all butterfly bushes, it blooms all summer without deadheading.
