

# Butterfly Gold Butterfly Bush



## ***Buddleia davidii* 'Butterfly Gold' (BUDHUR99) PP33807**

- **Use:** Yellow to white and green variegated foliage helps this plant stand out even before its blooms appear. Large, mauve-purple flower spikes bloom in Summer. A very fragrant and floriferous shrub with a dense, compact habit.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Cold, wet winters can be really hard on buddleia, so here are a few tips to help your buddleia thrive in your garden: 1. Make sure the soil is well-drained. 2. Full sun. That's at least 6 hours. No cheating. 3. Wait until it leafs out in spring before pruning. In some years you may have to prune it back to the ground. After milder winters, maybe not so much. Avoid fall pruning.
- **Growth:** Fast growing 6' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6a-9b; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Bright yellow, green and white variegated foliage that make it a great contrast against flowers.
- **Flower:** Fragrant, large, mauve-purple flower spikes appear in summer and attract butterflies in droves!
