## Buddleia x 'Chrysalis Series'

- <u>Use:</u> The Chrysalis™ series of Butterfly Bush is the most compact and well-behaved Buddleia available. The dense, dark foliage and fragrant flower spikes make them a must-have shrub for the smaller garden or container garden on a patio or deck. Pollinators flock to this shrub as it remains in bloom for the whole summer until the first frost.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Cold, wet winters can be really hard on buddleia, so here are a few tips to help your buddleia thrive in your garden: 1. Make sure the soil is well-drained. That place where the gutters drain out into the years? Not a good spot.. 2. Full sun. That's at least 6 hours. No cheating. 3. Wait until it leafs out in spring before pruning. In some years you may have to prune it back to the ground. After milder winters, maybe not so much. Avoid fall pruning.
- Growth: Moderate grower to 20-28" tall and 18-24"wide. Deadhead often for best reblooming.
- Hardiness: Zone 5a -9a; Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Silvery green foliage.
- Flower: Flowers are formed in early summer and continue to re-bloom into the fall. Spent flowers are hidden by new blooms, reducing the need for deadheading. .
