

Royal Red Butterfly Bush



Buddleia davidii 'Royal Red'

- **Use:** This 1928 hybrid from Good and Reese Nursery in Ohio is still one of the most sought-after of the butterfly bushes. May be used as a hedge or specimen plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 to 7 feet tall and 5 to 6 feet wide. Deadhead often for best reblooming.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Silvery foliage.
- **Flower:** Topped from early summer through fall with long panicles of delightfully fragrant, brilliant violet flowers; it's only red for color-blind butterflies and folks who write garden catalogs! FRAGRANT



Long-blooming shrub and very easy to grow! Jumps to 4' tall or more in one season!
