- <u>Use:</u> Makes quite a show as a specimen shrub, in a large perennial border, or as an informal hedge. Hummingbirds and butterflies alike will flock to the lightly fragrant multitude of white with yellow-throated flowers.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth**: Moderate grower to 8 to 10 feet tall and 6 to 8 feet wide. Deadhead often for rebloom.
- *Hardiness:* 6 -9 Shrub
 - **Foliage**: Deciduous. It has soft silvery undersides on its leaves which complement the white of the flowers.
- <u>Flower:</u> A good clear white flower that nonstop flowers May- October.
- Long-blooming shrub and very easy to grow! •
