

Leah™ Midnight Butterfly Bush



Buddleja x 'Leah Midnight'

- **Use:** Alluring nectar-rich, honey-scented flowers draw butterflies in droves. Large 8" trusses are comprised of hundreds of enchanting deep royal-purple florets each dotted with a sparkling orange eye. Slightly smaller-statured than classics with arching gray-green foliage allows for placement in space-challenged gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Improved branched giving unique compact mushroom growth habit growing 24-36" tall and 30-36" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small silver-green leaves that are very tight together on the stem.
- **Flower:** Forms tapering spikes of dense midnight-purple flowers, plants bloom continuously late spring thru early fall, fragrant flowers are butterfly magnets. Can also be used in cut flower bouquets.

Up to 5 months of continual flowering. Loved by butterflies, pollinators, and hummingbirds. Deer resistant.
