

Golden Glow Butterfly Bush



Buddleia weyeriana 'Golden Glow'

- **Use:** This yellow-flowered buddleia is a cross between the davidii and globosa types - giving long panicles of flower that go on through late summer, autumn and even to Christmas. Golden and scented it attracts every kind of butterfly, moth, etc. If you have room for only one buddleia, this should be the one you choose.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 6 to 8 feet tall and 6 to 8 feet wide. Deadhead often for rebloom.
- **Hardiness:** 6 -9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Long panicles of fragrant golden-yellow flowers bloom over a LONG late-spring-thru-fall season.

Long-blooming shrub and very easy to grow!
