Dwarf Miss Ruby Butterfly Bush









Buddleia x 'Miss Ruby'

<u>Use:</u> Miss Ruby is a sweetheart of a plant noted for its compact habit and remarkable vivid, rich pink blooms. The flower color is unlike any other Buddleia. This new butterfly bush has silver leaves, and has a compact growth habit. It is very well branched which results in lots of beautiful flowers. Developed by Dr. Dennis Werner of the JC Raulston Arboretum in NC.

Exposure/Soil: Full sun to part sun; moist, well drained soil; dislikes wet sites. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.

- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 4 feet tall and 3-4 feet wide. Deadhead often for best reblooming.
- Hardiness: 5 -9 Shrub
- *Foliage*: Deciduous. Silvery foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Nonstop large 1' long deep pink flower heads from May until frost.
