Buxus microphylla var. japonica 'Green Beauty'

- **Use:** An excellent evergreen shrub for small hedges. Retains its dark green foliage in the hottest summers, becoming bronze-tinged in cold weather. Well-suited to pruning into formal shapes. More heat, humidity and drought tolerant than other boxwood varieties. Other splendid characteristics include deer resistance and tolerance of dry soils once established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 5 ft. tall and wide, but can be trimmed to maintain a shorter height easily.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Retains its dark green foliage in the hottest summers, becoming bronze-tinged in cold weather.
- **Flower:** Spring flowers are inconspicuous.
