## Buxus sinica 'Wintergreen'

- <u>Use:</u> Excellent evergreen shrub for small hedges.
  Similar to Buxus microphylla japonica except darker green. Like other boxwoods, it can get red leaves in the winter in full sun.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers full sun to part shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide, when unpruned. However often shaped to 2' tall in topiary form.
- Hardiness: 5-10; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Evergreen; Small, obovate, medium green leaves (to 5/8" long).
- Flower: Spring flowers are inconspicuous.
