

Wintergreen Korean Boxwood



***Buxus sinica* 'Wintergreen'**

- **Use:** Excellent evergreen shrub for small hedges. Similar to *Buxus microphylla japonica* except darker green. Like other boxwoods, it can get red leaves in the winter in full sun.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide, when unpruned. However often shaped to 2' tall in topiary form.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Small, obovate, medium green leaves (to 5/8" long).
- **Flower:** Spring flowers are inconspicuous.
