- **Use:** This small rounded boxwood can be treated as a topiary form to create perfect spheres in the garden. Allow to grow into its more natural form for a filler or to cover up the unsightly base of house wall or fence line. Can be grouped in a row for edging, informal hedge or partition in the garden. Boxwood is so named because its very hard wood was valued in ancient times for making of boxes and small containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part shade. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Slow grower to 3 ft. tall and wide in an oval shape, when unpruned.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Densely branched, the tiny, green foliage is abundant and adds a distinctive note to the landscape. Protect from drying winter winds to prevent tip dieback. Some bronzing in winter cold.
- **Flower:** Spring flowers are inconspicuous.
