

Purple Beautyberry



Callicarpa dichotoma 'Issai'

- **Use:** Good for massing or individually in woodland plantings. Spring flowers and beautiful fall fruit make this an attractive landscape plant. Use it in semi-shade under tall pines. Deer resistant, Drought tolerant. Beloved by the birds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun or shade, but light shade is best for berry set. ; moist soil; prefers ample water in hot dry locations.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-4' tall and 3-5' wide. If overgrown prune to 6-18" tall; will regain height in one season.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8, shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; It has emerald green foliage throughout the season. The narrow leaves do not develop any appreciable fall color.
- **Flower:** Lavender pink flowers from June until August. Flowers on new growth.
- **Fruit:** Pink summer flowers turn into lavender berries from September until March.
