Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.





Calistemon citrinus 'Woodlander'

- <u>Use</u>: Bred in South Carolina by Woodlanders Nursery. Arching stems with narrow dark green leaves and intense red flowers. DROUGHT TOLERANT!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun—part sun. Prefers welldrained soils. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 6-8 feet tall, to 6-8 feet wide.
- Hardiness: 7-11, Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen, alternate, simple, 1" to 3" long and less than an inch wide.
- **Flower:** The significant show of red bottlebrush spikes in summer.
