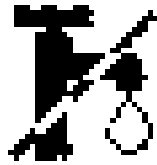


Venus Allspice/ Sweetshrub



Calycanthus x 'Venus'

- **Use:** Very fragrant! 'Venus' calycanthus is a glorious explosion of large magnolia-like flowers appear in early summer. Has a unique, fruity fragrant, particularly in the evening. Developed by Dr. Tom Ranney of NC State University. Very easy and fast to produce.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun or shade. Highly adaptable to many soil types and grows in sun or shade, though it blooms more when grown in full sun. Native from Virginia to Florida.
- **Growth:** Grows 5-6' tall and 6-8' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; Glossy, aromatic, leathery, dark-green foliage matures to a golden yellow in autumn.
- **Flower:** Large, magnolia-like white flowers with yellow and purple central markings are delightfully fragrant in early summer and appear intermittently thru the season. Flowers are long-lasting and branches may be cut to enjoy blossoms indoors.
