Camellia japonica 'April Blush'

- **Use:** Flowers make a dazzling contrast with the glossy, dark green foliage. An old favorite. Also very nice when grown in very large containers on the front porch. Parentage: 'Bernice Boddy' X 'Dr. Tinsley' A Camellia Forest Introduction.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- **Flower:** Shell pink semi-double blossoms. Blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade.

Tolerates heat and humidity well!
