

# April Tryst Camellia



This red camellia deserves a place in high profile foundation planting or as a backdrop to outdoor living spaces in the backyard.



## *Camellia japonica* 'April Tryst'

- **Use:** A handsome shrub with glossy dark green leaves and very showy, fragrant red flowers that arrive in late winter to early spring. More cold tolerant than most varieties; typically blooms later in spring in colder regions. The upright, vigorous form grows quickly when young, filling in nicely as an evergreen hedge, screen or foundation plant.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade form afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 5 to 8 ft tall, 4 ft. wide. Larger with time.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Glossy, dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Admired for its red anemone, formal double blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade.
