Camellia japonica 'Greensboro Red'

- <u>Use:</u> A vigorous grower and truly remarkable Camellia. The lustrous, rich green toothed leaves provide a wonderful backdrop for the flowers. To enjoy and show off the striking flowers inside the home take some cuttings and display in your favorite vase or float just one in a bowl of water.
- **<u>Exposure</u>**: Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- *Growth:* Moderate growing to 10 ft. tall and 6-8' wide, larger with age.
- Hardiness: Zone 7a-9b; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for dark green foliage.
- <u>Flower</u>: Boasts large, almost artificial looking, super-glossy semidouble flowers with black-veined, wavy deep red petals that surround contrasting bright yellow center stamens. The flowers usually open a red to dark red and then turn to deep red displaying black in the veins and around the edges on the second day. <u>Prune only right after</u> <u>blooms fade.</u>
