Camellia japonica 'Blood of China'

- **Use:** Flowers make a dazzling contrast with the glossy, dark green foliage. An old favorite.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- **Flower:** Magnificent, deep pink, peony form bloom features a delightful fragrance. Blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade.
