- <u>Use:</u> This unusual beauty will give you a stunning spring display with its glossy leaves reflecting the sunlight, and the beautiful blooms opening to reveal their white outer petals and creamy-yellow ruffled centers.
- <u>Exposure</u>: Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade from afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Consistent and even moisture is important. Avoid wet soils. <u>Plants require protection from direct afternoon sun and wind.</u> Best with a root mulch.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small glossy green foliage.
- <u>Flower</u>: Sure to light up your garden in late winter and early spring with its anemone-form flowers with creamy, antique yellow centers surrounded by creamy-white petals. <u>Prune only right after blooms</u> <u>fade.</u>
