

# Brushfield Yellow Camellia



Tolerates heat and humidity well! A must have in every Southern garden.



## *Camellia japonica* 'Brushfield Yellow'

- **Use:** This unusual beauty will give you a stunning spring display with its glossy leaves reflecting the sunlight, and the beautiful blooms opening to reveal their white outer petals and creamy-yellow ruffled centers.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade from afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Consistent and even moisture is important. Avoid wet soils. **Plants require protection from direct afternoon sun and wind.** Best with a root mulch.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 6 to 8 ft. tall and wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small glossy green foliage.
- **Flower:** Sure to light up your garden in late winter and early spring with its anemone-form flowers with creamy, antique yellow centers surrounded by creamy-white petals. **Prune only right after blooms fade.**
