Gorgeous flowers that are deer resistant and bring interest to the winter garden!

Camellia japonica 'Covina'

- **Use:** Covina Camellia features showy fuchsia round flowers with yellow eyes at the ends of the branches from late winter to early spring. It has dark green evergreen foliage. The glossy pointy leaves remain dark green throughout the winter. Camellias are used as specimen large shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant.
- **Exposure:** Thrives in either full sun with good irrigation (and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun) . Must amend the soil! As they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Can grow 6-10' (could be up to 12' tall in 15 years)tall and wide. Space plants 4'-6' apart to create a hedge.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6b-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** Beautiful semi-double, deep-rose to rose-red flowers cover this upright shrub in winter.
