

# Fire Falls Camellia



## *Camellia japonica* 'Fire Falls'

- **Use:** A beautiful deep red flowering camellia with dark green foliage and large semi-double flowers that are nearly 3+ inches in diameter. Flowers appear in late winter- early spring. Camellias make great small, evergreen landscape trees when pruned up and even work well in large containers.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 8 to 10 ft. tall and 6-8' wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Large red, peony style flowers. March-April. Prune only right after blooms fade.
