- <u>Use:</u> Camellias are used as specimen large shrubs, shrub borders and screens. The main ornamental feature is their showy flowers in colder winter months when other plants are dormant.
 - Exposure: Thrives in either full sun with good irrigation (and some work), but prefers partial sun (Morning Sun). Must amend the soil! As they hate red clay! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower 6-8' tall and wide, but taller over 20 years. Space plants 4'-6' apart to create a hedge. Prune only right after flowering.
- Hardiness: Zone 6-9; shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen. Shiny, rich dark green leaves.
- <u>Flower</u>: Spectacular, deep red, formal double blooms are displayed against glossy, dark green foliage.
