Camellia japonica 'Jerry Hill'

- **Use:** Jerry Hill Camellia features showy rose round flowers with pink overtones at the ends of the branches from mid winter to early spring. It has dark green evergreen foliage. The glossy pointy leaves remain dark green throughout the winter. Its upright vigorous habit makes it a choice camellia as a specimen plant. The sensational blossoms can be used as a corsage or floated in a bowl of water to add beauty to any room.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade form afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 10 to 12 ft. tall and wide, and 10 feet wide at the base forming an upside down cone.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- **Flower:** Admired for its clear pink, formal double blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade. Make great cut flowers in a vase or float the flowers in a bowl of water.
