Camellia japonica 'Lemon Glow'

- <u>Use:</u> This sport of 'Dahlohnega' appears slightly more yellow in the flower than its parent plant. Small to medium-sized, formal double, soft creamy yellow flowers held against the starkly contrasting foil of deep green foliage are produced in mid to late season, January to April. Lem-on Glow Camellia is a highly sought after, large flowered Japonica with a slow rate of growth and an upright to rounded, densely branching habit. Its slower growth habit lends this cultivar to container culture and bonsai as well as a prized addition to the garden and landscape.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site from hot afternoon sun, in partial shade. Best in moist, acidic, organically amended, well-drained soil.
- **<u>Growth</u>**: A mid-size Camellia with an upright habit of growth to about 8 to 10 feet tall and 6 to 8 feet wide. Slow grower.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 6-9; Shrub
- Foliage: Evergreen; Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for glossy green foliage.
- *Flower:* The medium sized fully-double, lemon yellow flowers are outstanding against the green foliage. Early to late season. <u>Prune only right</u> <u>after blooms fade.</u>
