- <u>Use:</u> Blooming over a long season from late fall into early spring, this is a beautiful specimen with perfect formal double flowers. The rosy-pink, 3" flowers are set against deep green foliage. Its upright vigorous habit makes it a choice camellia as a specimen plant. The sensational blossoms can be used as a corsage or floated in a bowl of water to add beauty to any room.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, prefers a little bit of shade form afternoon sun, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing to 10 to 12 ft. tall and wide, and 10 feet wide at the base forming an upside down cone.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 6-9; Shrub
- *Foliage:* Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> Admired for its large, rosy- pink, formal double blooms from December through March. <u>Prune only right after blooms fade.</u>
