Camellia japonica 'Rosea Plena'

- **Use:** One of the oldest and finest Camellia varieties.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 10-12 ft. tall and 3-10 ft wide, and taller after many years.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Vigorous, compact, upright, evergreen shrub, valued for small pale green foliage.
- **Flower:** Admired for its pure pink, formal double blooms from December through March. Prune only right after blooms fade.
