

Smiling Face Camellia



Camellia x 'Shibori Egao'

- **Use:** "Variegated Smiling Face" (transl.) originated in Kurume, Japan. Medium pink semi-double blooms are blotched with white due to benign virus. This same virus causes yellow variegation on some leaves.
- **Exposure:** Prefers sheltered site, sunny or shade, and any well drained neutral/acid soil. Extreme summer heat may cause leaf burn; needs some shade if planted near a white house due to reflection of sun.
- **Growth:** Growing to 8-10ft tall and 8-10ft wide, larger with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen Glossy dark green foliage may have some yellow variegation and makes a great hedge in shade.
- **Flower:** Semi-double blooms are a medium size in a medium pink with white blotches and moiré. Blooms late fall-winter. Prune only right after blooms fade.

Tolerates heat and humidity well!
Deer resistant.
