Camellia japonica 'Tama Vino'

- <u>Use:</u> Introduced by Nuccio's Nurseries of Altadena, CA in 1993. Seedling of C. japonica 'Tama-no-ura'
- **Exposure:** Prefers morning/middle of the day sun with afternoon shade (to prevent foliage burn in late summer). Must amend the soil! Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- Growth: Upr
- ight growth can be kept 6-8' tall if pruned right after blooming, but can eventually grow 12-15' tall without pruning. Spacing 5' apart to create a tall/solid hedges, otherwise 14'+ for space between plants to create individual shrub look.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 7b-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark green, glossy foliage is an excellent foil for flwoers in the garden year round.
- <u>Flower</u>: Medium sized flowers at 3-4" wide, semi-double, deep wine red with narrow white border in December to March-April (varies by weather).
